What about a mouse or a donkey? Draw and write about how you would clean the animal's teeth.</p>	<p>Create treasure map. Soak your map in tea to make it appear like an ancient map. Do you have a compass on your map?</p> 
<p>Construct a Weather Chart. Include the minimum and maximum temperature.</p> 	<p>Keep a tally of all the arms and legs you see in a day. Arms on people, legs on animals, tables and chairs. Look out your window to see arms and legs. You may count them by 2's. How many can you find in a book?</p>	<p>Find things in your house in every colour of the rainbow. Draw and label the things you find.</p> 	<p>Have a Living Room disco – play freeze, musical chairs, have a dance off.</p> 
<p>Make puppets or use your toys or a sock to put on a puppet show.</p> 	<p>Make collections of an even number of things. What is half of each collection? What fact can you write about even numbers?</p> 	<p>Fold paper planes and see how far they will fly.</p> 	<p>Write a list of names that begin with each letter of the alphabet. Now write a list of foods. Which list was harder to write? Why do you think that?</p>
<p>Interview the members of your family. Ask them about their favourite music, food or places to visit.</p> 	<p>Make a meal with your family. Write down the list of ingredients and all the steps involved to cook your dinner. Draw a picture for each step. Enjoy your yummy meal!</p>	<p>Play charades. Can you make the actions of an animal (without any sound) so others can guess what you are?</p>	<p>Create with Lego - make a pencil container, a robot or even a box for your tissues.</p>
